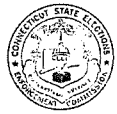

The respondent(s) allegedly violated the law as follows:

Christopher J. Taylor was elected to the Bridgeport Board of Education in November 2017 and currently serves today. He did not reside in Bridgeport when he ran for office in both 2015 & 2017, did not reside in Bridgeport the day he took his oath of office in 2017, and does not reside in Bridgeport today.

Christopher Taylor is a convicted felon with an extensive criminal record. He is closely aligned with the Democratic Town Chair, Mario Testa.

In conducting research to find credible evidence that Christopher Taylor does not reside in Bridgeport, I uncovered a maze of fraud & deceit related to potential bank/ mortgage fraud, which is being investigated by another agency. I also found a bevy of LLC's with business addresses identified at four different jails, prisons and correctional facilities in CT. In addition, officers & members of the LLC's are inmates with identified inmate numbers. Both LLC's business addresses and member addresses are identified as 120 Middle Street which is a U.S. Post Office in Bridgeport.

The Exhibits regarding LLC's and Lawsuits pertain to the SEEC complaint because they go directly to the respondents credibility, a variety of different addresses different from his voter registration addresses in Bridgeport, and the service of many of the

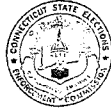

lawsuits were at his actual abode of 270 Bronson Rd., Southport, CT. Christopher Taylor has filed litigation and LLC's stating he was a resident of Southport, CT while he was registered to vote and actually voting in Bridgeport. In fact, he voted in Bridgeport this past August 14, 2018 in Bridgeport and on the very same date created an LLC with his residence identified as 270 Bronson Rd. On July 20, 2017, the very night Christopher Taylor was nominated by the Republican Town Committee to be a candidate for the Bridgeport Board of Education, DMV notified the Bridgeport Registrar to remove Christopher Taylor from the Bridgeport voter rolls and notified the Fairfield Registrar to re-enroll Taylor at 270 Bronson Rd., Southport, CT. According to the IT Director of the Secretary of State, this DMV notification is only triggered with an address change associated with a license renewal. Less than four hours later, than Deputy Republican Registrar, Cisco Borres, re-enrolled Christopher Taylor at a completely new address in Bridgeport which is a recycling business owned by Mr. Taylor. This is in a Light Industrial Zone that does not allow ANY residential occupancy. The Blueprints clearly shows the Scale House is exclusively office space and does not meet the definition of the Zoning Regulations. Christopher Taylor was fully aware that it was in an Industrial Zone/Non-residential as he filled out all 4 Building Permits for the structures located at 155 Davenport St. Than Assistant Deputy Registrar Cisco Borres and Republican Registrar, Linda Grace, attended the Republican Convention that very night and voted to endorse Christopher Taylor as a Republican Board of Education candidate. On July 25, 2017, Cisco Borres switched Christopher Taylor to a Republican five days after he was nominated. On August 16, 2017, the Fairfield Registrar removed Taylor and on August 22, 2017, Cisco Borres added Taylor in a flurry of activity coded as "maintenance."

In November 2017, Christopher Taylor finished ahead of challenger Howard Gardner by just 16 votes which resulted in a recount. Howard Gardner only needed to draw 8 votes away from Taylor which is possible in a citywide recount.

I could not attend the recount due to back surgery, however I kept in touch with Howard Gardner during the recount via the phone. The recount was conducted by Registrar Sandi Ayala with her daughter Inez Ayala. Throughout the day, Howard Gardner relayed that there was suspicious activity in which Registrar Ayala & I. Ayala repeatedly left the recount area with documents, were huddled and whispering, and failed to announce the results of the recount at its conclusion. Howard Gardner only needed 8 votes to tie with Taylor, yet Gardner picked-up 0 votes and Taylor picked-up 8 votes giving him a 24 vote plurality. This was highly irregular and suspicious. I believe the recount should be audited, but especially absentee ballots. Comparing the number of absentee ballots reported by the Town Clerk versus what was actually counted in the recount is of significant importance.

In current litigation, Taylor filed a Pro-Se appearance in his own handwriting identifying his address as 270 Bronson Rd., Southport CT and provided his lease filed on the land records in Fairfield which states he has a lease from March 2015 - March 2062 and is paying \$400 per month to reside there. That case is still pending and Taylor is identified as a defendant residing at 270 Bronson Rd., Southport, CT. Taylor filed a lawsuit against Arizona University with the first sentence of the complaint stating Taylor is a resident of Southport, CT while he was registered to vote and voting in Bridgeport.

In reviewing Chris Taylor's finance reports for Mayor in 2015, and the Board of Education in 2017, there are numerous violations. Taylor repeatedly made campaign donations knowingly utilizing inaccurate or false addresses in violation of state law. The violations related to voting, serving as an elected official, and campaign finance filings are significant and flagrant.

I am attaching a twenty three page Exhibit Index with hundreds of pages of exhibits. It is critical to read the Index which outlines the significance of each exhibit. It is labor intensive and time consuming to review the index while reviewing the correlating exhibit, however it is important to do so.



Until such a vote, neither the Commission nor its staff will release or confirm any information about the complaint except upon written request of a treasurer, deputy treasurer, chairperson or candidate affiliated with a committee that is the subject of the complaint or preliminary investigation.




