The respondent(s) allegedly violated the law as follows:

Jessica Martinez currently serves as both Chair of the Bridgeport Board of Education (BBOE) and as a member of the 137th District
Democratic Town Committee (DTC). She was elected to the 137th DTC in both 2016 & 2018 and was elected to the BBOE in
2017. She served as Treasurer of the Dennis Bradley 23rd Senatorial Campaign in 2018 and is part of that ongoing investigation
in which I filed an SEEC complaint. She is also closely aligned with Bridgeport Board of Education Member Chris Taylor whom is
also being investigated by the SEEC based on a SEEC complaint I filed asserting he is serving on the BBOE illegally as he is a
resident of Southport, CT. Orlando Baez is Jessica Martinez' significant other and does not hold municipal office nor is he a
member of the DTC.

#### CONCISE STATEMENT OF FACTS continued

I have been highly suspicious of Jessica Martinez' residency in the 137th District since April 2019. In April 2019 Jessica Martinez called me regarding her sons schooling. She sounded quite frazzled and frantic and asked for my advice regarding a Control Transfer for her son. She went onto explain that she had withdrawn her son from Notre Dame due to finances and that he had not been enrolled in any school for two weeks. She further stated that although his neighborhood high school was Bassick High School she wanted her son to attend Central High School. Although I did not share it with her, in my mind red flags were immediately raised as I knew that any high school student residing in the 137th District would automatically be assigned to the neighborhood school of Warren Harding High School, therefore if her son's neighborhood school was Bassick H.S. he could not possibly be residing in the 137th District. I set about quietly trying researching Jessica Martinez' residency, however I was unable to find any indisputable evidence to support my suspicions. I was told that her son was residing with his father while Jessica & Jose Martinez were in the midst of a divorce, therefore I did not pursue the matter at that time. The January 9, 2019 CT Post article also referenced Jessica Martinez was facing an eviction and I knew those records were public. After researching Jessica Martinez' eviction I was able to locate the complaint, a copy of her lease, text messages, her pro-se appearance and more. On November 6, 2019, Attorney Daniel Arcobello filed an eviction due to non-payment of rent against Jessica Martinez on behalf of Stone Bridge Properties after a Sheriff served Jessica Martinez on October 11, 2019 with a Notice to Vacate by October 24, 2019. Jessica Martinez failed to vacate her apartment by the deadline. The address Jessica Martinez is being evicted from is 50 Milne Street, Apt. 3LB. The address is located in the Hollow section of Bridgeport in the 131st District which requires she vote at City Hall located at 45 Lyon Terrance. A copy of the lease states she signed the lease on April 3, 2019, well before the July 23, 2019 DTC Convection, September 10, 2019 Primary and November 5, 2019 General Election.

Jessica Martinez failed to appear for two separate court dates, therefore the plaintiff prevailed and she was ordered to vacate or be removed by a Marshal. On January 7, 2019, Jessica Martinez filed a Pro-se appearance, and numerous additional documents in her own handwriting with 6 of those documents being signed by her and 4 of those documents identifying her address as 50 Milne Street, Apt. # 3LR directly below her signature. One of these documents was a "Motion to Squash Execution" stating stating in part that "the defendant has no other safe, adequate, and affordable place to live and/or cannot move before the date set for eviction" which would contradict any attempt by Jessica Martinez to now claim any other residency in the 137th District. As of November 5, 2019, neither Jessica Martinez nor Orlando Baez had changed their voter registration from 761 Noble Avenue located in the 137-01 Precinct of Luis Munoz Marin School to their proper residence(s). On Tuesday, July 23, 2019, Jessica Martinez attended the Democratic Town Committee Convention as the 137th District Town Committee and participated in nominating in a BBOE candidate, cast a vote for Joe Ganim for Mayor and voted to endorse Aidee Nieves and Maria Valle to serve as the 137th City Council candidates although she clearly had no right to do so. Once she moved to 131st District in April 2019 she had vacated her 137th District Town Committee seat and could no longer represent Democrats residing in the 137th District. Furthermore, on both September 10, 2019 and November 5, 2019 Jessica Martinez voted in the Democratic Primary and the General Election in the 137th District at Luis Munoz Marin School when she was required to vote in the 131st District at City Hall located at 45 Lyon Terrace. In September 2014, then State Representative Christina Ayala was arrested and charged with several crimes that it appears both Board of Education Chair Jessica Martinez and her significant other Orlando Baez may have committed, although Jessica Martinez' alleged criminal violations are more significant and extensive.

Should the SEEC find these allegations to be true I am urging the SEEC to refer this matter to the Chief State Attorney for criminal
prosecution so that both Jessica Martinez and Orlando Baez can be charged with at minimum the following felony counts:
- General Statute 9-360 - for fraudulently voting in an election or primary which they were not eligible to vote.
- General Statute 9-361- for unlawfully voting in a primary in which they were not eligible to vote
- General Statute 9-357- for fraudulently procuring themselves to be electors
In addition, Jessica Martinez should be charged with any relevant crimes for illegally serving on the 137 Democratic Town
Committee and nominating, endorsing and voting for city wide and 137District candidates at the Democratic Convention held
on Tuesday, July 23, 2019 when she had no legal authority to do so.
As you are aware, a number of elected and appointed municipal officials, DTC members and campaign operatives in
Bridgeport have been found guilty of betraying the people's trust, voter, elections and absentee ballot fraud which has
resulted in prison sentences, fines, and penalties. Clearly, that has not been enough to curtail illegal behavior.
However, the vast majority of Bridgeport residents believe our elected/appointed officials and DTC members should demonstrate
the highest level of integrity, honesty, morals, values and principles as representatives of the people. And, when those
expectations and standards are not upheld there must be accountability. We can no longer tolerate or accept those who make a
mockery of our democracy and democratic principles, or trample on the belief that public service is ingrained in the principle of
what is in the best interest "of the people, by the people, for the people."
