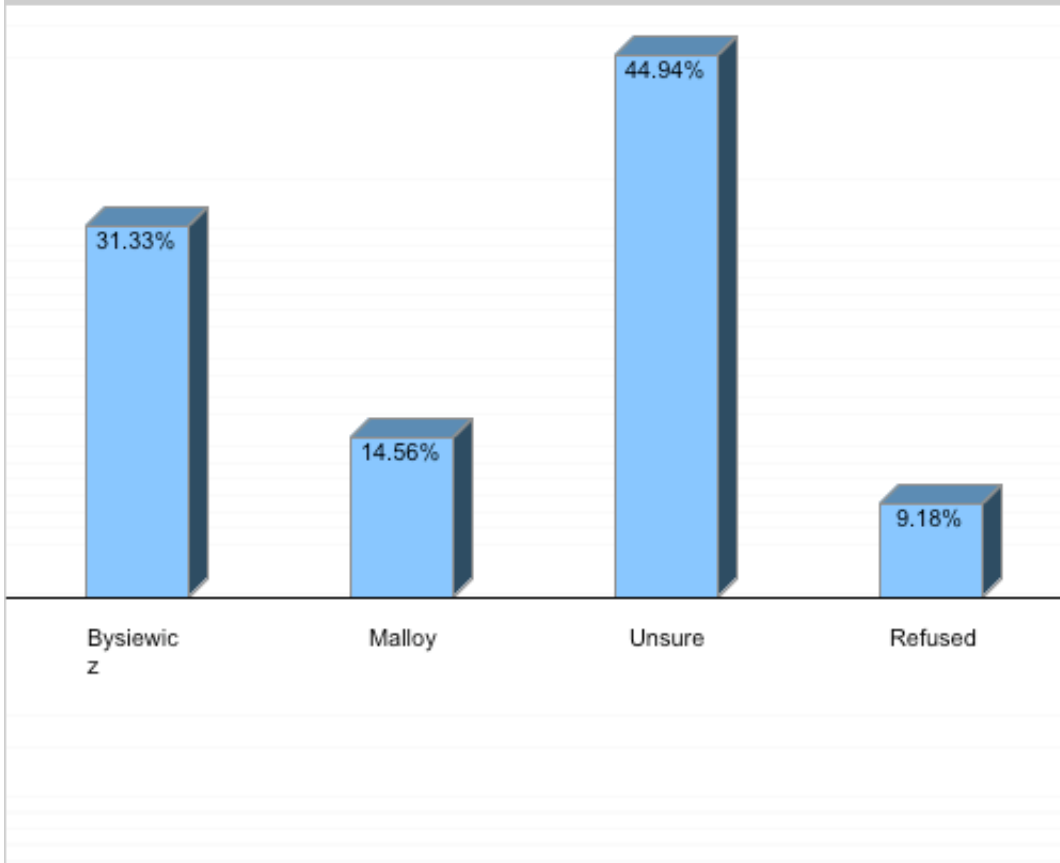


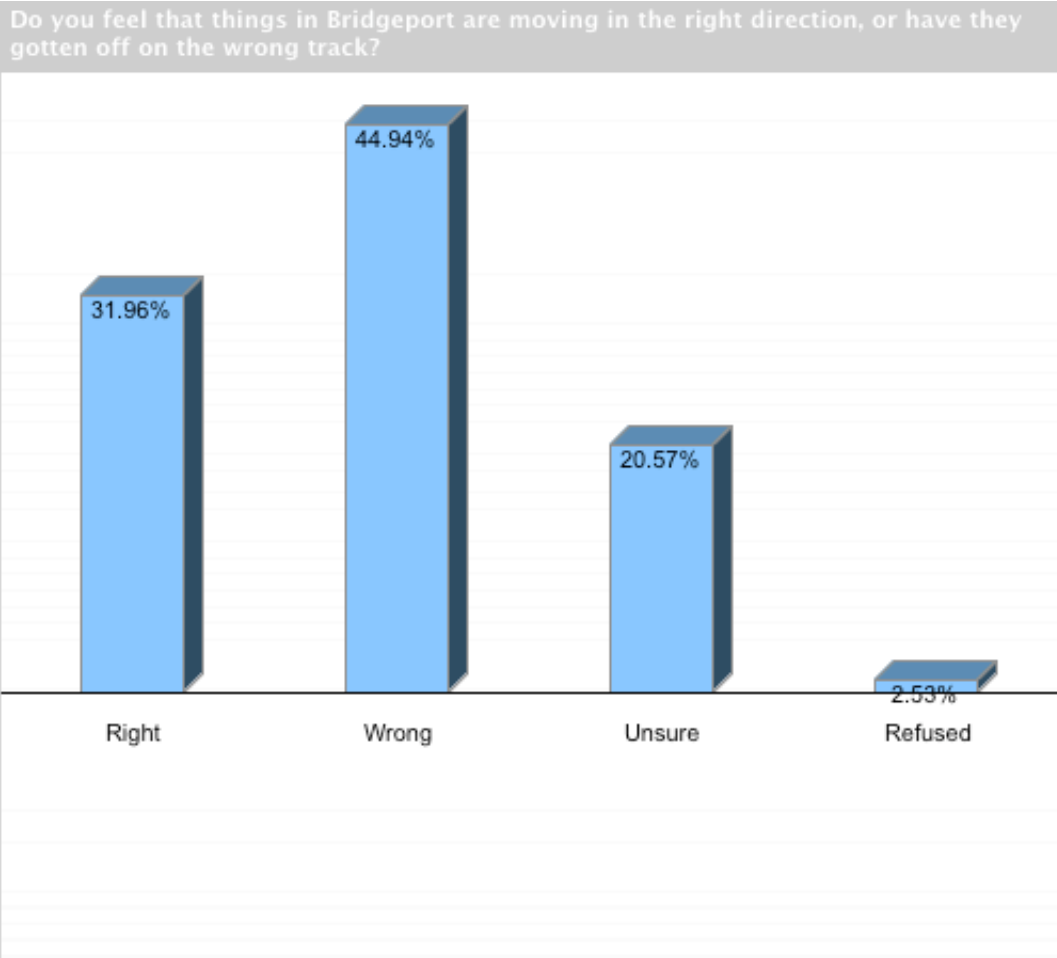

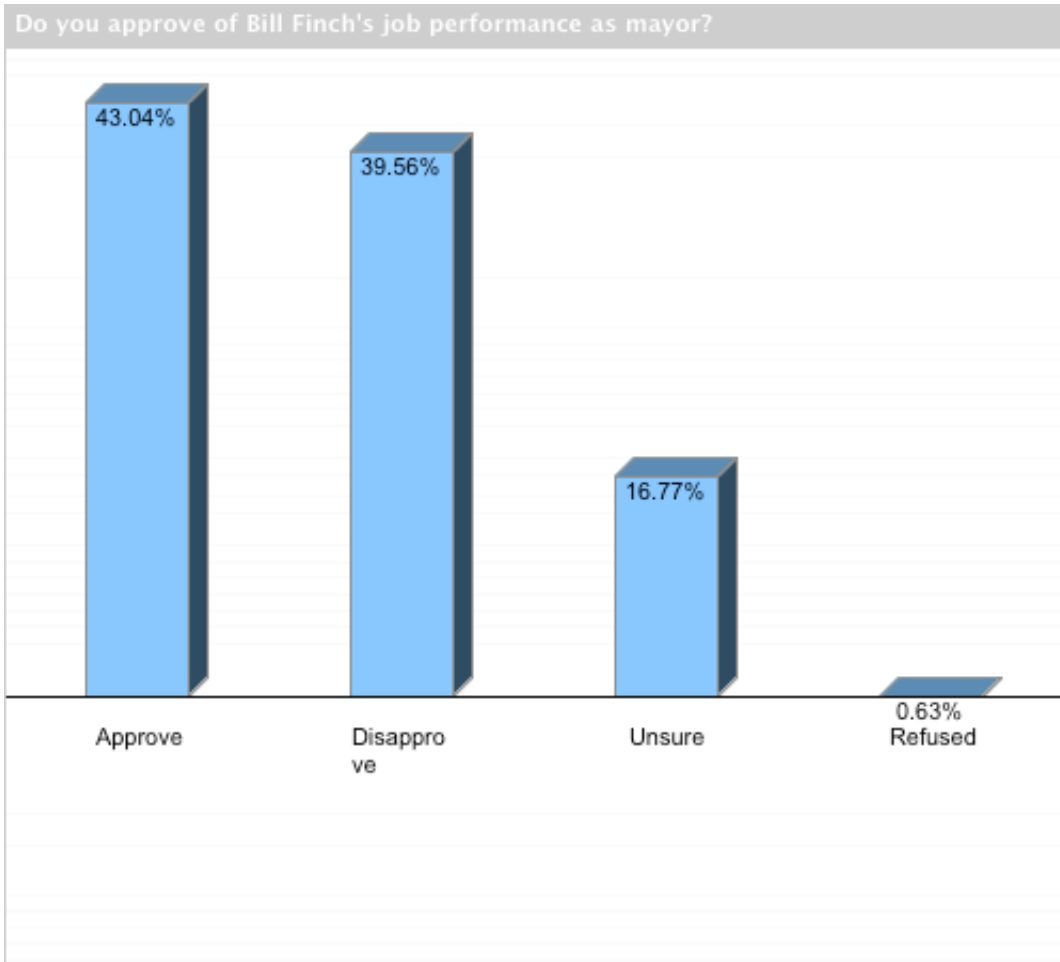
Do you feel that things in Bridgeport are moving in the right direction, or have they gotten off on the wrong track?

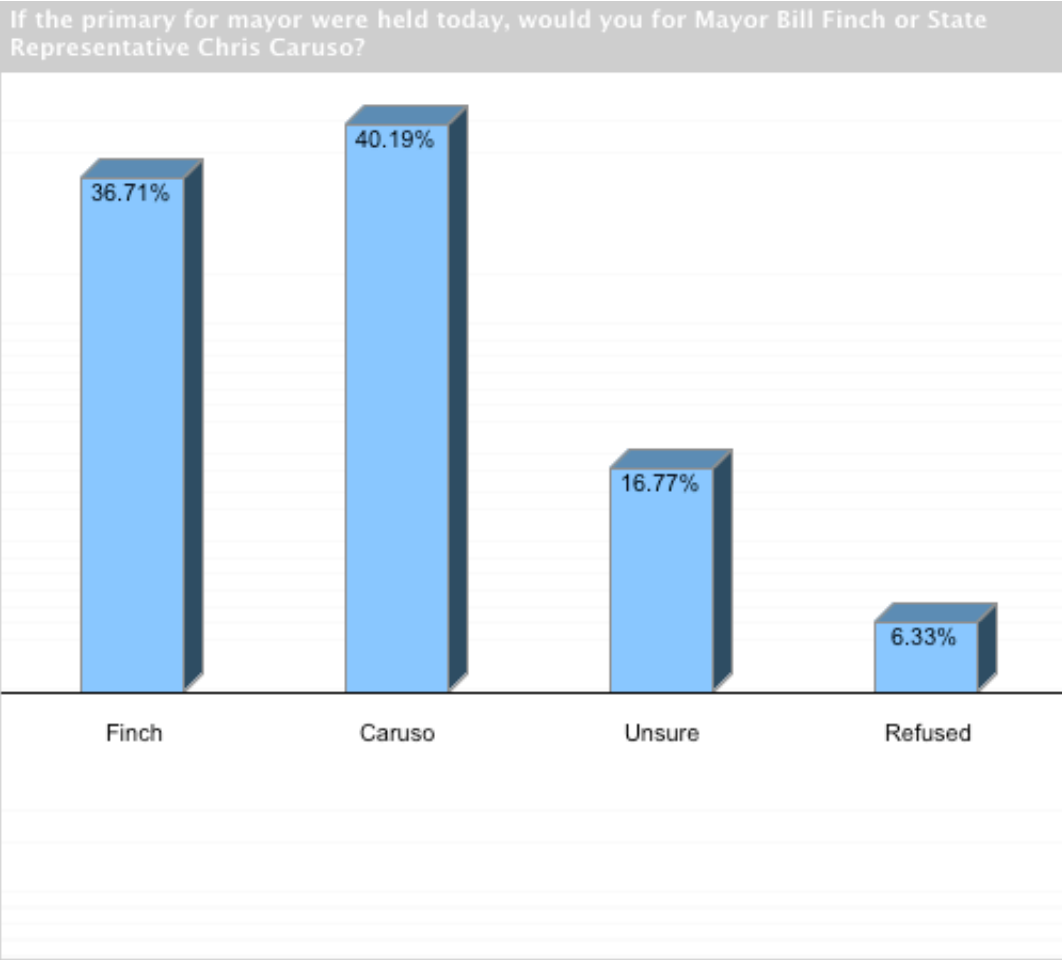
Do you approve of Bill Finch's job performance as mayor?

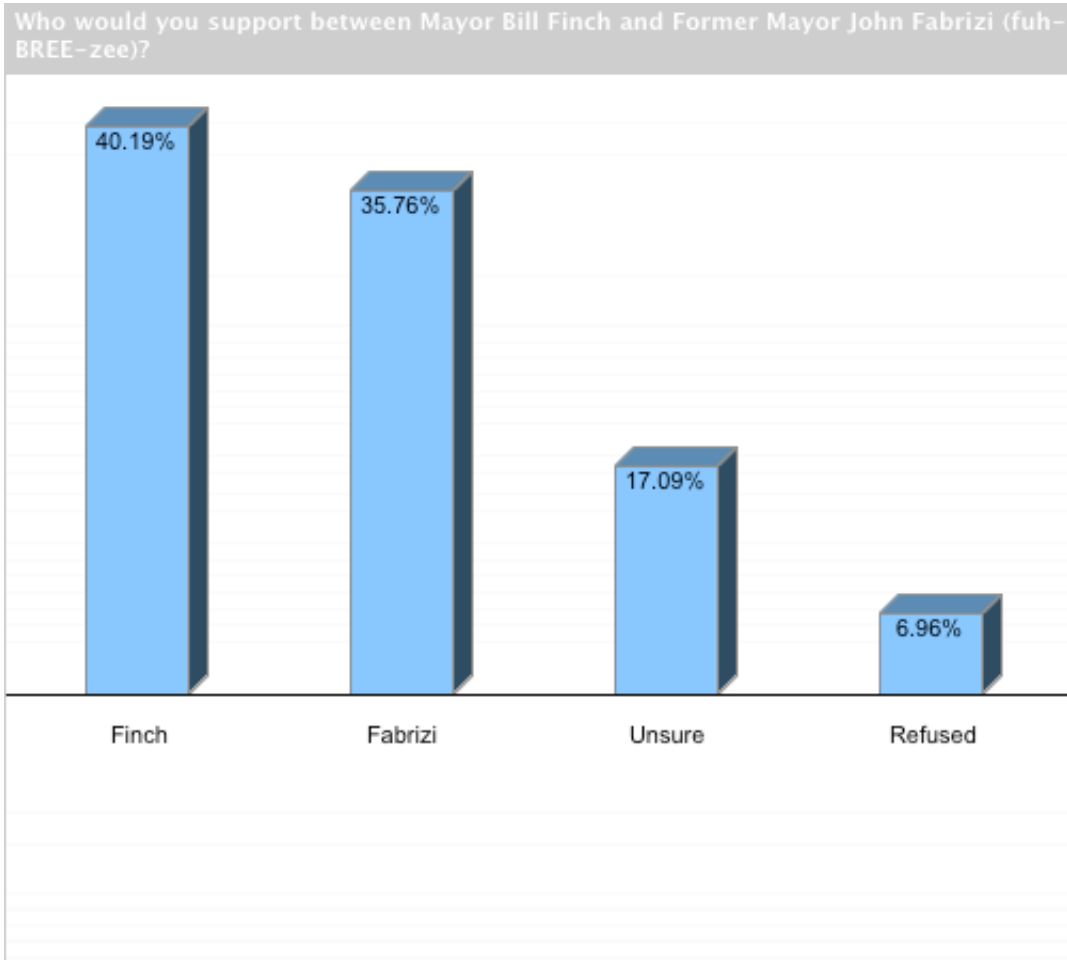
If the primary for mayor were held today, would you vote for Mayor Bill Finch or State Representative Chris Caruso?

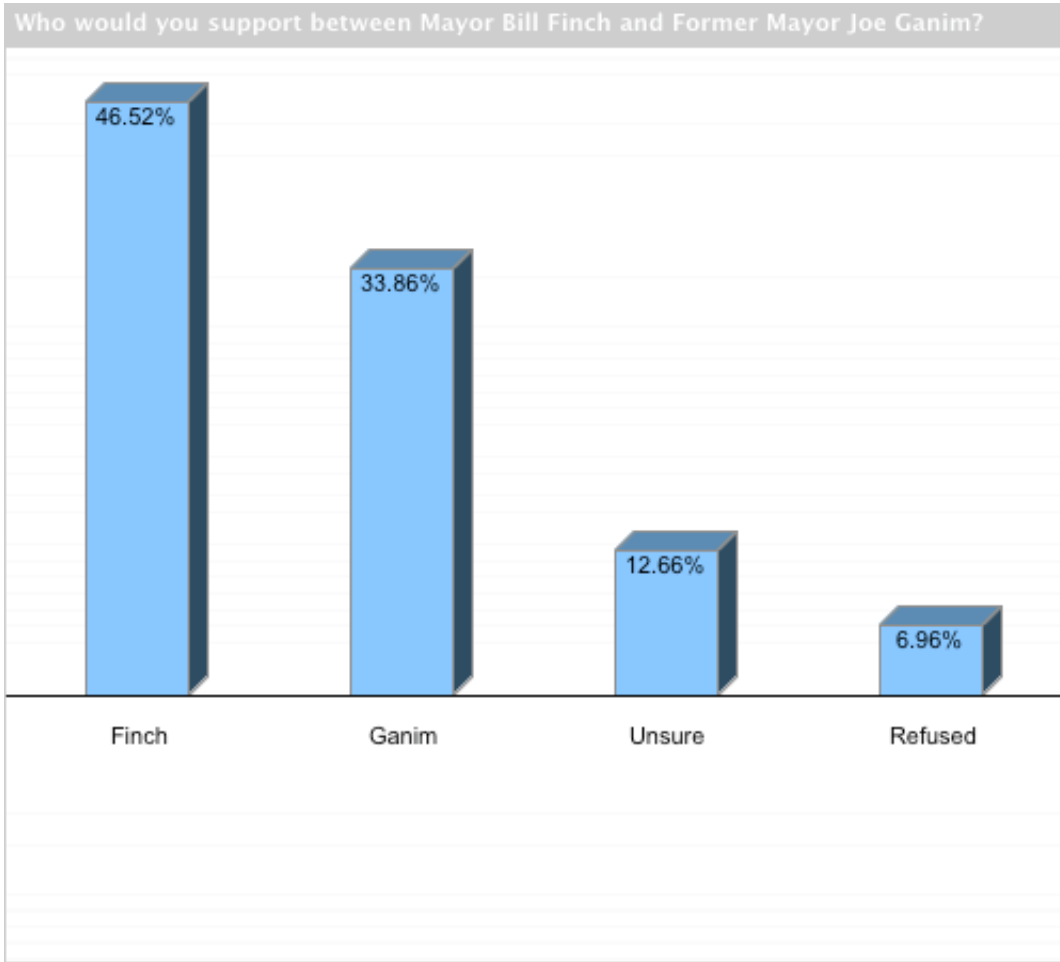
Who would you support between Mayor Bill Finch and Former Mayor John Fabrizi (fuh-BREE-zee)?

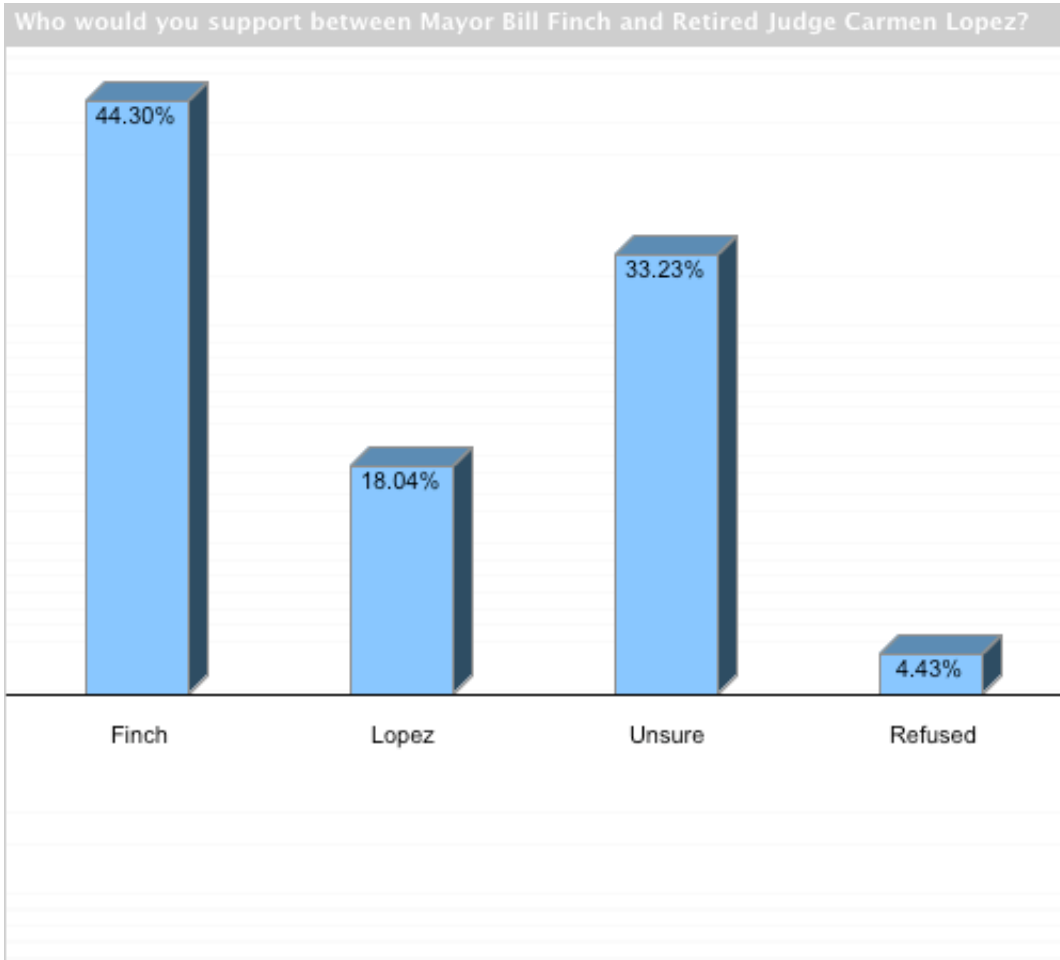
Who would you support between Mayor Bill Finch and Former Mayor Joe Ganim?

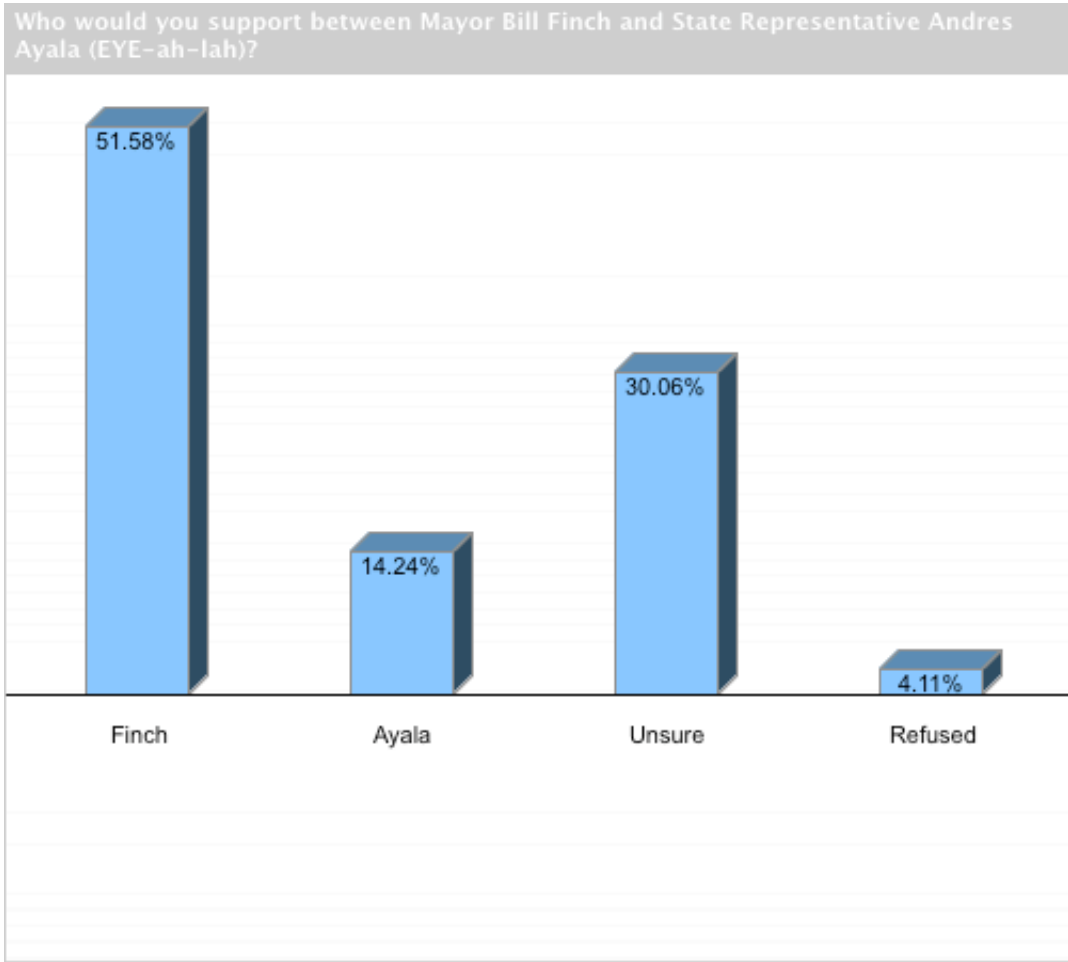
Who would you support between Mayor Bill Finch and Retired Judge Carmen Lopez?

Who would you support between Mayor Bill Finch and State Representative Andres Ayala (EYE-ah-lah)?

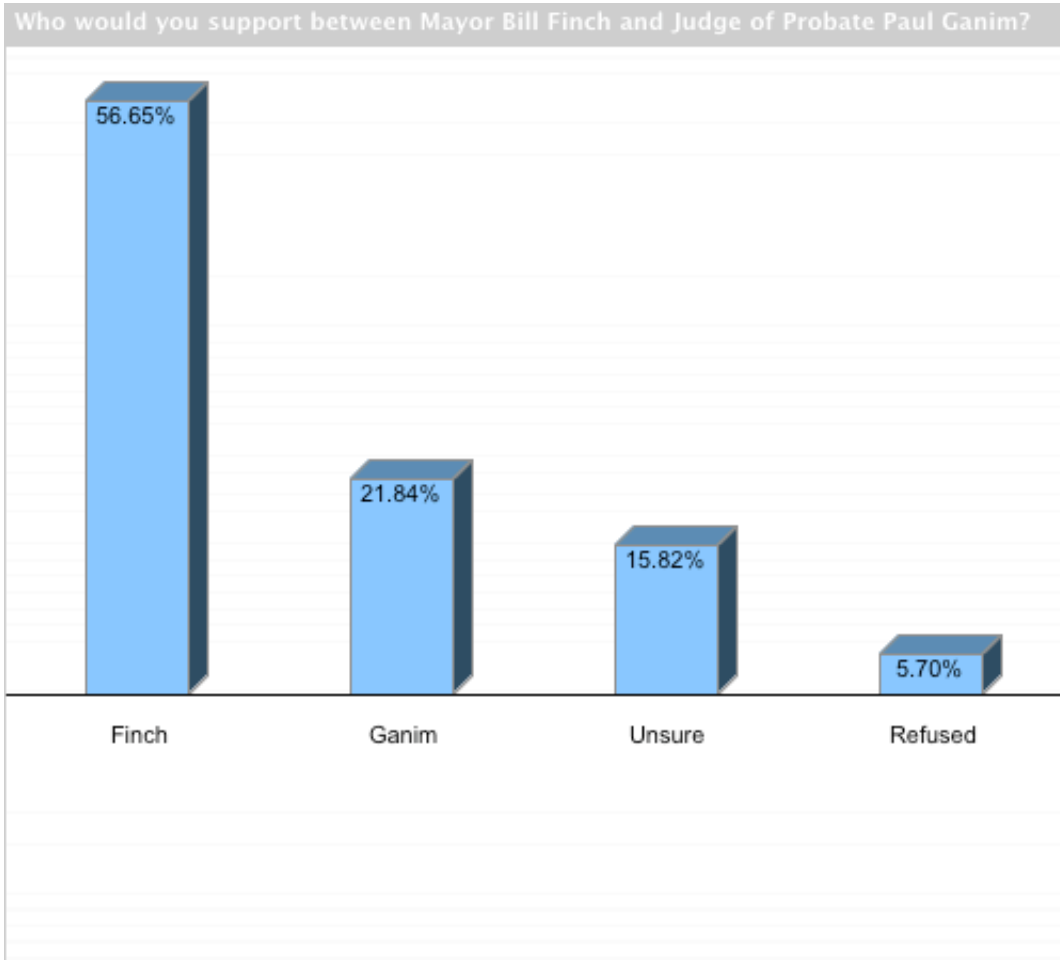

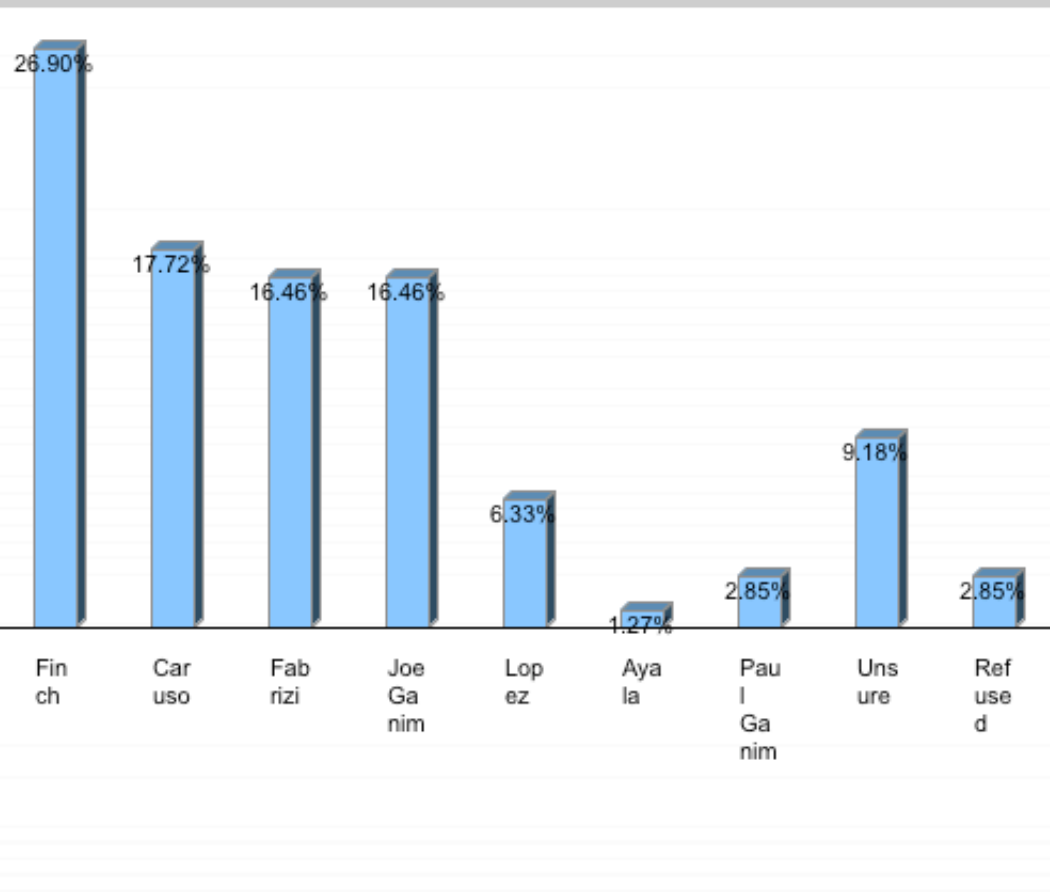

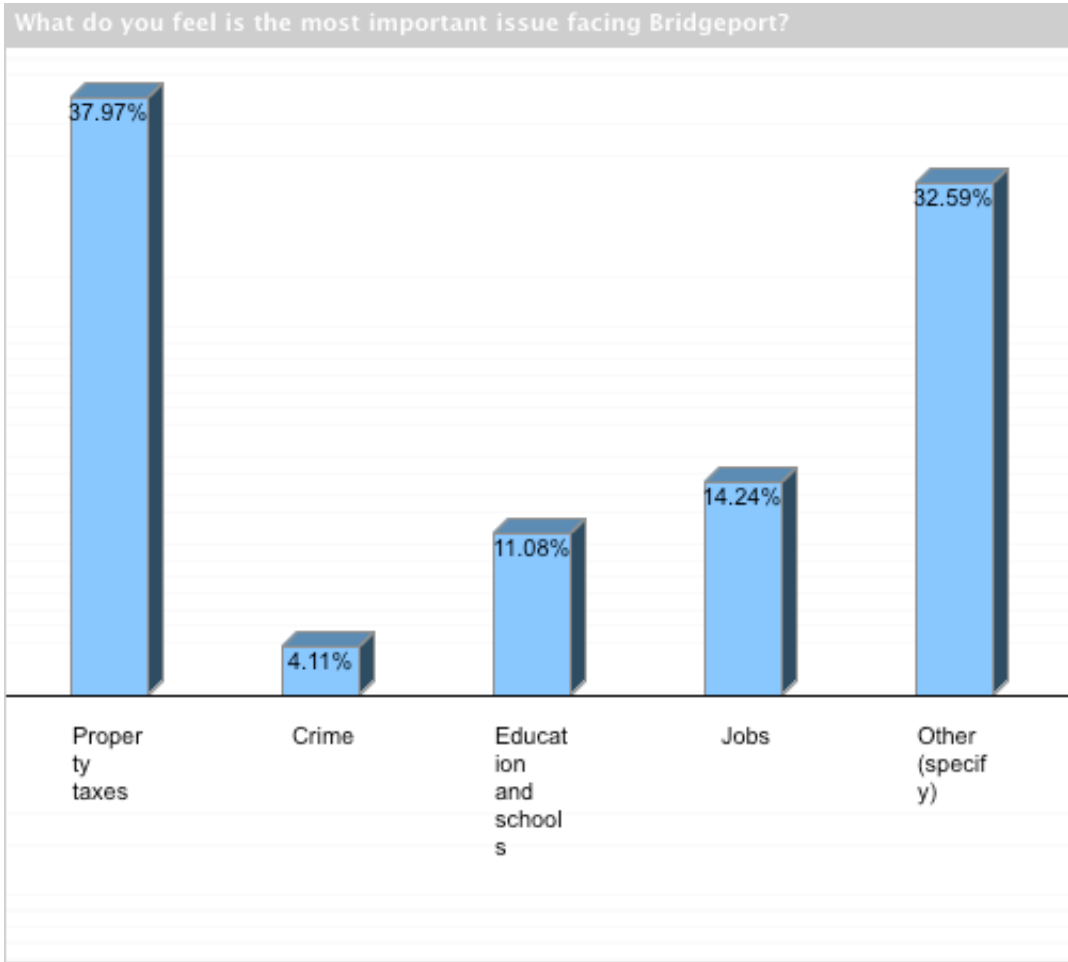
